

Read Naturally Startup/Setup

1. Open RN
 - a. Click on the “Start” tab, “Programs”, “Read Naturally”, “Teacher Management”
2. Log-in
 - a. Log-in using your first name or “suond116”.
3. Choose Student
 - a. Click on “Show My Students”
 - b. Click on your first student’s name
4. Student Placement:
 - Accurate way
 - a. Click on your student’s name
 - b. Click “Place Student”
 - c. Using your data, guesstimate the student’s reading level at a whole or half level between 1 and 7.
 - d. Click Continue
 - e. Click on the story that matches the level you chose (it will be highlighted)
 - f. Click “Next”
 - g. Click Yes
 - h. Student then clicks start when they are ready to begin reading aloud (you need to listen to them read)
 - i. After 1 minute the computer will sound a bell
 - j. You will then be prompted to click the last word the student read, and type the number of errors the student made
 - k. Click OK, then click next
 - l. You will then either get a recommended level or be prompted to continue assessing
 - m. Click OK then click save
 - Quick (but not as accurate) way
 - a. Click on your student’s name
 - b. Click “Story Options”
 - c. Choose a level and goal according to your grade level placement sheet (on reverse)
 - d. Click Save

6. The student can then begin to work with Read Naturally on another computer.

NOTE: Do NOT back-up when it asks... choose NO

NOTE: You should have 1 computer set up for Teacher Management and the rest set up for student stories so that when you are finished with one student, they can go to a computer, enter their password, and begin, and you can continue assessing students. If you have two programs running at once, hold down “Alt” & “Tab” at the same time to switch programs.

NOTE: To print student passwords: Log-in to Teacher Management, click “Students”, “Show My Students”, “Scores/Reports”, “Student Enrollment”, “View Report”. When it opens in another window, print it (make sure you know where you are printing it to).
