1. Place students with partners. Distribute a set of Word Sort Cards to each pair.
2. Tell students which words will be the “slap” cards. (homophones)
3. Each student holds half of the cards facedown. When you say go, one student turns over a card, and as quickly as possible, places it face up in a stack.
4. Both students read the card aloud. If the word on the card is a slap word, both students try to be the first to slap the card. The player to slap the card first collects the stack of cards.
5. Have students continue playing until one player has all or most of the cards.
